It just reminded me just how good I have it here!

Now is the time to get back to work. Even if you aren't comfortable yet with coming back to church, there are still things you can do. I want to encourage all of you to get reconnected. For some that might look like getting back in the habit of coming to worship, Bible study, or a ministry team meeting. The church is sprayed daily, and masks are required indoors. We do this to try and keep everyone safe. Get back to worship. don't let the pandemic lead you to the bad habit of disconnecting from JPC.

If you are in an at-risk group or don't feel safe, my request of you is still the same. Get reconnected. I have noticed that the number of people watching services online is slowly going down. That is due in part to the fact that some of you have

SCOUTS CORNER

BSA defines Scout Spirit as:

Scout Spirit applies to how Scouts live and conduct themselves in their daily lives. He or she shows Scout Spirit by being a role model to his/her peers, living by the Scout Oath and Law. The concept of Scout Spirit is not based on how many Scouting events or outings a Scout attends, but rather by how they help bring out the best in others as a reflection of his/her own character and attitude in his/her daily life.

In 2015 while at CSR summer camp, I purchased the patch shown here primarily because of the great colors. This year, I wear it due to the message. Note the date is 2000 and shows the Scout Spirit shining (yellow light) on the BSA Scout (Unknown) and Scouter (William D. Boyce), a Chicago publisher that brought Boy Scouts to America in 1909.



At the June 2021 Court of Honor for Troop 5068 (girls), I felt honored and humbled when Scout Master Susan G. told me that the Scout Spirit Award would now be known as the “Tom Coolidge Scout Spirit Award.” Scout Spirit and Scout of the Year are awarded twice a year. After sharing a few uses of a walking stick, I then presented the unique walking stick to Maddie O. Now the stick will be known as the “Scout Spirit Stick”

The program has been quite some successful and will be introduced to the Akela District this fall. My heart swells to bring this initiative for strengthening Scout Spirit with current and future Scouts.
